IH London Young Learner Centre



The programme takes place at the **University of Westminster's** modern Marylebone campus.

The University of Westminster has a tradition of educating stretching back more than 175 years. It currently has more than 20,000 students on their undergraduate, postgraduate and professional courses with students from over 150 different countries making it one of the largest and most diverse international student bodies of any UK University.

Situated on Marylebone Road opposite Baker Street Underground Station IH London Young Learner Centre offers excellent transport links around London as well as being close to the tranquility of Regent's Park.

The campus is very safe, with a secure 24 hour reception situated at both the main entrance and the entrance to the accommodation – Marylebone Hall.



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Marylebone Hall is a modern 21 storey building attached to the University, each floor holds two clusters of six flats and each room has a single bed, desk, wardrobe, storage space as well as private en-suite facilities.

There is a Common Room within the accommodation with a television, pool table and games table which students are free to use.

Rooms are cleaned every day and bed linen changed once a week there is also a card operated launderette within the accommodation and International House staff are happy to assist students in using the launderette.

Safety

We take safety of our pupils extremely seriously. The ratio of adults to students is 1:10 for all 14-17 year olds. We have first-aid trained staff and a school nurse who is available to see children every day in the school.

The English Explorer Programme

This course is perfect to help junior students gain skills and confidence using English language, whilst having lots of fun, learning about history and culture that London has to offer.

The programme is focussed on:

- Ü Improving spoken English
- Ü Increasing vocabulary

- Ü Exploring the most famous city in the world and its surroundings

All students receive 15 hours of tuition a week. However, even during the afternoon activities, students are practicing their English language skills at all times.

The best thing about the course is that the class curriculum is integrated into the afternoon activities, so the Sherlock Holmes Experience day is a fun day learning all about the famous fictional detective. There is a lot to learn about the Royal family, the history of the Government, the Beatles and so on.
